Founded in 1958, The Philadelphia Ceili Group is a non-profit, volunteer, educational organization (governed by a nine-member Board of Directors), which is dedicated to the preservation, education and promotion of Irish Culture through a variety of activities including Irish Ceili dances, Traditional Irish Music concerts, a yearly festival, instructional workshops, storytelling, theater, family friendly programming and Irish community building. The Commodore Barry Arts and Culture Center, also known as the Philadelphia Irish Center, is a nonprofit community building used by many of Philadelphia's Irish diaspora and the local neighborhood for activities, community events, parties and fundraisers. The PCG cosponsors monthly events with the Irish Center on the First Friday for the Irish music session and ceili dance instruction, the upcoming Ceili Dance on March 17, St. Patrick's Day, and our Next Generation & Ceili Og family day on the Second Sunday.
