As President of the Commodore John Barry Arts & Cultural Center (the "Irish Center"), I, along with the Board of Directors, am dedicated to keeping our donors informed annually about the Irish Center's developments.

This year, the major update is the retirement of several board members. Kathy McGee Burns, Tom Farrelly, Barney Boyce and I are retiring from the Board of the Irish Center as of July 1, 2025. We will honor their contributions at the Summer Fundraiser on July 20th at Great American Pub in Conshohocken (details are posted on our website). Although stepping down from the daily operations, we will continue to offer strategic guidance as emeritus members.

The Irish Center's mission is to sponsor and support programs and activities in the Greater Philadelphia area that teach, celebrate, and promote Irish art, history, culture, and heritage. Our vision is to honor our ancestors, showcase our history and culture and support Philadelphia's multi-cultural beauty.

Currently, fulfilling this mission is challenging due to our high overhead expenses, including \$10,000 monthly operational costs, deferred maintenance, and notably low event attendance. Cultural institutions like ours face increasing difficulties in today's world, where shifting interests, economic pressures and competing entertainment options make it harder to attract and retain audiences. Over its 66-year history, the Irish Center has faced similar challenges, which are typical for cultural organizations. As a 501(c)(3), we are positioned to navigate these difficulties and find our place in today's world.

I am confident in the new board and officers to redefine the Irish Center's role, mission and vision while honoring our heritage.
